It is only the day the FIRST EVER POSNOC participant was randomised!



Facts about POSNOC!

- 1491 participants randomised to date
- 111 UK hospitals opened
- 21 Australia and New Zealand sites opened

How time has flown, five years later & we are just about to randomise participant number 1500! That is nearly one randomisation a day (including weekends) every day for the past 5 years!
